




Reason for recusal: Defendant served as Court Bailiff for many years and all local Judges have worked with him.

The Grand Jurors for the State of Tennessee, duly elected, impaneled, sworn, and charged to inquire in and for the body of the County of Scott, in the State of Tennessee, upon their oath, present: That

prior to the finding of this indictment, on or about May 20, 2015, in the County and State aforesaid, did unlawfully and intentionally or knowingly cause bodily injury to Lane Robbins, in violation of T.C.A. 39-13-101, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.

And the Grand Jurors aforesaid, upon their oaths aforesaid, do further present: That **MICHAEL RAY WILSON** prior to the finding of this indictment, on or about May 20, 2015, in the County and State aforesaid, did unlawfully and intentionally or knowingly cause bodily injury to Addison Caldwell, in violation of T.C.A. 39-13-101, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.

And the Grand Jurors aforesaid, upon their oaths aforesaid, do further present: That **MICHAEL RAY WILSON** prior to the finding of this indictment, on or about May 20, 2015, in the County and State aforesaid, did unlawfully and recklessly engage in conduct which placed or might have placed another person, to wit: Lane Robbins, in imminent danger of death or serious bodily injury, in violation of T.C.A. §39-13-103, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.

And the Grand Jurors aforesaid, upon their oaths aforesaid, do further present: That **MICHAEL RAY WILSON** prior to the finding of this indictment, on or about May 20, 2015, in the County and State aforesaid, did unlawfully and recklessly engage in conduct which placed or might have placed another person, to wit: Addison Caldwell, in imminent danger of death or serious bodily injury, in violation of T.C.A. §39-13-103, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.
